Editors Comments

The responses and support received from the newsletters are encouraging. We urge readers to distribute the newsletter articles where they feel led to. We need to inform as many people as we can. Donations to the ministry have blessed us greatly and your prayers are treasured above all, as this is armoury against the attacks of the enemy.

We are also receiving calls and letters by people who have been disturbed and grieved by things that are happening in many churches today. Many are being broken. Others are having difficulties in finding a church that will teach the Bible without the 'wildfire'. The fallout rate from the 'Toronto Blessing' has accelerated with many leading Charismatics now seriously concerned about the direction that the Pentecostal and Charismatic churches have gone in recent years. Hardly a mainline denomination has not also been affected. We cannot do more than warn and exhort people everywhere to be informed of the real fruit that is beginning to surface from these excesses, which now seem to be accepted as normal in many churches. We praise the Lord that He is separating many in these days from error. It is my belief that as in the days of Noah and Lot the Lord will look for a remnant that is faithful to His Word and His ways. These people may often be called bigots, narrow-minded, intellectuals, pharisees, judgemental, critical or people who have 'missed out on blessing'.

I was recently talking to a Pentecostal Pastor in charge of many churches in his area. He stated that when the 'revival' comes that it will only come to the Charismatic spirit-filled churches who are open to this 'move of the spirit'. This is very similar to cultish ideas by which many cult groups keep and deceive their people. However, John 12:48 should bring us all to caution: *He that rejecteth me, and receiveth not my Words, hath one that judgeth him: The Word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day.* We will be judged by the Word, not by any blessing or 'move' of the spirit, especially if it is not scriptural. The 'Toronto Blessing' and other past 'waves' of the spirit have not been scriptural! The false prophecies associated with these things should bring people to repentance, but sadly an increasing number of people like sheep continue to be sucked into one error after another, year after year.

I feel it is time for many to get out of a ship that is sinking because it is rotting with false teaching and additions to the Word of God. It is time for people to be simply satisfied with what the Bible says and abide within it. Let us wait upon the Lord even if it be in dry times. Let the winds of false doctrine and the 'waves' of the spirits and the so-called 'blessings' blow around you. Take only that which you see clearly in the Word of God. Our reward is not of this earth but waits for us as a crown in Heaven. Seek His holiness and righteousness which come from Heaven above and we will not be ashamed when we see Him face to face in all his glory. In these perilous days let us look forward with joy to the unspeakable shock of the beauty of the kingdom of Heaven! Terry Arnold



Dictionary of Terms:

Monarchianism (or Adoptionism):- Anti-trinity; introduced 2nd & 3rd. Century; Taught that Christ was made and adopted by God and was a perfect being. Dynamic Monarchianism:- Denied Deity; believed only the power of God rested on Jesus; Was first taught by Artemon, Paul of Samosata and Theodotus. Docetism:- Believed Christ was not human; that he only 'seemed' human. Gnosticism:- Held to 'secret knowledge'; introduced by pagan philosophies; Was also a mixture of astrology and some Christianideas. Was infecting Christianity as early as the time of Iranaeus (AD130-200). Ebionites:- A sect of Jewish Christians in 2nd Century; practised strict asceticism and being poor; Were the first to rejected deity of Christ; Many also disbelieved virgin birth. Arianism:- Founded by Arius (AD250-336); Denied 'eternity' of Jesus; Believed Jesus was created by the Father out of nothing; Was opposed by St. Athanasius AD296-373 and

condemned at Council of Nicea AD325. Appolinarianism:- Introduced by Appolinarius AD310-390; He opposed Arianism and taught that Christ was all divine and not human. This was condemned at Constinople AD381. To reject the humanity of Christ is to reject the incarnation - that God clothed himself in flesh to redeem humanity. Nestorianism:- From Nestorius AD451; Taught that human and divine natures were separate... that Jesus was two persons. Was rejected at Council of Ephesus AD431. Monophysitism (or Eutychianiam):- Taught that Jesus was divine and had only one nature, not two; Was condemned at Chalcedon AD451 Monothelitism:- Similar to Monophysitism and was fought out in the 7th Century. Taught that Jesus had one single divine will and energy only. At Constantinople AD680 it was settled that Christ had two wills. 'Toronto Blessing' News

- In New Zealand, the impact of the T.B. is continuing. 'Rick Jenkins, organiser of last year's Moriel tour by Jacob Prasch and Philip Powell, was ex-communicated from his Upper Hutt Baptist Church on account of his stand against T.B. This unreasonable act was carried out after Mr. Jenkins, on his request, met with the elders of the church who are reported to have been unwilling to consider his view point.' (C.W.M. vol. 2, No.1).
- In both islands of New Zealand significant numbers of Christians have withdrawn from churches, particularly AOG, and joined other churches. One observer states that there is an increased 'hunger and thirst in a lot of Christians who are now earnestly seeking correct doctrine and teaching from pastors rather than exciting experiences and hype'..
- A former student of a leading AOG Bible college writes, 'I am a recent graduate of Southern Cross Bible College, the training centre for AOG in Australia. At the November 25, 1995 graduation ceremony Wally Odin 'preached' and openly attacked those who would be against this 'move' of the spirit. College president, David Cartledge said the college was 'radical' - a Holy Spirit college. During the year Mr. Cartledge's preaching has been purely 'Toronto' ie. dialogue on his personal experiences that he can't explain either logically or from scripture, and re-hashed airport vineyard 'revelations'. Because of this emphasis on 'Toronto', hostility towards those who would dare to discern, and cronyism within the AOG Australia, I don't feel I can in all honesty remain associated with them. I am tempted to 'go independent' but would prefer to be answerable to and receive support from an organised group of ministers...'(C.W.M. vol.2, No.1)
- Cases of mental problems and manic behaviour, directly attributed to transference of spirits from Toronto type meetings, are increasing. Cheryl Thomson, managing Director of 'Strangers and Pilgrims Christian Evangelism Fellowship' in Toronto, with her husband, was formerly heavily involved with the Vineyard movement. She writes: '...two people in Toronto who have experience in deliverance ministry ... are starting to see cases of severe problems in people who have been attending the Toronto Airport Vineyard...Personally, I'm afraid that the body of Christ has opened a Pandora's box. In that ancient Greek myth, Pandora opened a box, and a horde of evil things escaped from it.. Spiritual counterfeits is a subject which was given expert, comprehensive treatment in the book 'War on the Saints' by Jesse Penn-Lewis with Evan Roberts. It was written in the early 1900's, following first hand experiences of the supernatural in the famous Welsh Revival. [Yet] Rick Joiner [Kansas City Fellowship] has written: 'Jesse Penn-Lewis may be one of the classic historic examples of how heresy hunters are used by the enemy to derail true works of the Holy Spirit' .**...I believe that a great 'falling away' (2Thess.2:3) has already begun...Those who do not love the truth will believe a lie, for God Himself will send them a strong delusion (2Thess.2:11)...Demonic powers, I believe, have gained control over the Vineyard Movement and the Kansas City Fellowship 'Prophetic Movement,' as well... I believe 'The Vineyard Movement' is playing an important role in preparing the way for this terrible End-Time Delusion'.*** *Rick Joiner (associated with Paul Cain, Francis Frangipane and other 'Prophets' from Kansas City.** 'Morning Star Journal'*** 'Not Just a Memoir of 'The Vineyard': 1986-1994' by Cheryl Thomson.

WYAM & 'Reconciliation Walk'

Lyn Green, the European director of WYAM (Youth With a Mission), is proposing a 'reconciliation walk' in which thousands of Christians will retrace the old routes taken by the crusaders. The aim is to come face to face with Muslims and Jews to repent of the acts and the sins of the crusaders. Lyn calls the crusaders 'Christians' yet goes on to speak of the slaughter of tens of thousands of Muslims and Jews, including women and children, during the crusades.

It is a sad fact that this history has been so well re-written or twisted that people like Lyn Green perhaps have only half the truth! The truth is that the Crusaders were essentially *Catholic*, not Christian! They were sent by the Popes to make peoples subservient to the rule of the Pope. They did in fact slaughter not just Muslims and Jews but *Christians*, ('Protestants'), who refused to submit to the church or the pope.

The first wave of crusaders were a mob of untrained peasants who were dominated by religious superstitions. The first and second waves murdered, raped and plundered their way towards Jerusalem. In 1099 the more professional crusaders reached Jerusalem and on the 15th July they broke into the city and slaughtered men, women and children throughout the day and into the night. This included burning 6000 Jews in a synagogue. Some fled to a mosque where the crusaders there slaughtered an estimated 30,000 Muslims.

However, what about the 10,000 Waldenses slaughtered in the mountains of Piedmont; 20,000 defenceless men, women and children in the city of Bezieses, and the 70,000 Protestants during the week now termed the 'Bartholomew's Massacre'? It has been estimated that the thirty years between 1540 and 1570 saw 900,000 Protestants killed!

The Bartholomew's massacre in France was ordered by Catherine De Medici with the backing and support of the Catholic Church. On August 24, 1572, 70,000 Huguenots were massacred. The Pope and cardinals rejoiced and sang thanksgiving songs. A medal was made in honour of the day and congratulations were sent to the king and queen's mother.

Some of the crusades sent by Popes make shocking reading. At Lavaur in 1211, the governor was 'hanged on a gibbet and his wife thrown into a well and crushed with stones. Four hundred people in this town were burned alive. The crusaders attended a Catholic high mass in the morning, then proceeded to take other towns in the area. In this siege it is estimated that 100,000 Albenges (Protestants) fell in one day. Their bodies were heaped together and burned.'* In the massacre of Orange in 1562, (approved by Pope Pius IV), men were 'commanded to slay men, women and children. The command was carried out with terrible cruelty, the people being exposed to shame and torture of every description.'*

Yes, repentance and reconciliation should be made to the Muslims and Jews slaughtered by the crusaders. However, this needs to be made with an understanding of the truth about these events. They were not done in the name of true Christianity but in the name of *Catholicism* and 'infallible' *Popery*. It was not only Muslims and Jews who were slaughtered but also a multitude of Christians! Let us be well *informed* of the history of false religion. Those who refuse to learn from history are doomed to repeat it.

The Story of Thomas Watts - Lest We Forget

Thomas Watts lived in the harsh days of 16th century England at Billericay, Essex. He worked as a linen draper in a shop.

In those days the queen was Mary Tudor, a Roman Catholic. The compulsory state religion was Roman Catholicism.

Like many before and after him Thomas Watts refused to accept the Catholic 'Mass' because it was unbiblical. Roman Catholicism states that the Mass 'offers anew to God the victim of Calvary* In the Mass Jesus really offers His life.'* .He knew that the Bible clearly stated that Jesus was not to be offered again, (Heb.6:6), that he was offered 'once for all', (Heb.10:10, see also 9:25,26).

Thomas knew he would be in trouble for his stance so he sold his business, put his affairs in order and made provision for his wife and family. The rest he gave to the poor and needy.

On 26th of April 1555 he was arrested and charged with nonattendance at church. He appeared before Bishop Bonner and agreed with the law of the land, but refused to deny his Biblical beliefs and submit to the Church of Rome. He was examined several times but his interrogators gave up and sentenced him to die. He spent time in Newgate prison and was brought back to Chelmsford for execution. He spent his last night at Scot's house, a riverside inn, with others who shared the same fate.

On the day of his death he had such peace that two of his children offered to die with him. On June 10th, 1555, he was secured to a wooden stake at the market place, (near the present shire hall). Before he was burned, he gave a final challenge to Lord Rich - to repent of the evil he had done. He was then lit and burned to death.

Thomas Watts was ready to die and forsake all the world had to offer. He was ready to face God. This was not because of what he had done but because of who Christ is and what He had done. Jesus is the only one true Lord and saviour and He died a cruel death to take our place in sin, and pay the ultimate once and for all price. Did You Know?

Did you know that all the knowledge acquired from the beginning of human history to AD1750, doubled by 1900, ie. in 150 years? It doubled again in the next 50 years (to 1950). Saving Souls For Dollars

In Brazil the fastest growing Pentecostal church has made news in the Time Magazine. The brazil-based Universal church of the Kingdom of God is one of the fastest growing churches in the world with 3.5 million attending 2,200 'temples' in 34 countries. Its leader is self-ordained Bishop Edir Macedo Bezerra. A former pastor has written a book called 'In the Corridors of the Kingdom', and charges that many of the ministers are charlatans who live in luxury on the 2% to 10% of the weekly collection plate they take for themselves.

The church has an annual cash flow at between \$750 million to \$1 billion. Macedo has built up a secular Brazilian empire that includes a major TV network, 26 radio stations, 2 newspapers, a bank and a recording studio. Macedo, who conducts church business from a mansion in Purchase, New York, denies any bad dealings. However, Police in several countries are investigating charges of fraud, Tax-evasion and links to drugs.

Time Magazine says, 'The Pentecostal formula - energetic singing, theatrical exorcisms and dramatic testimonies of miracles cures - has strong appeal for the Brazilian underclass. Moreover, like the other Protestant sects sweeping Latin America, the church promises riches in this world in return for faith and hard work'. (Time Magazine, March, 1996)
