The Fraud of a 'Man with a Mission'

In the Sunday Telegraph, March 2nd, 1997, Father Dennis Madigan writes in a column titled 'Man with a Mission'. At the end of his usual social Gospel he quotes a text of scripture titled 'Today's Text'. Exodus Chapter 20 is quoted which is the passage detailing the ten commandments. What most readers do not know is that his text conveniently misses out the second commandment! The second commandment reads: 'Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth: thou shalt not bow down thyself to them; for I the Lord thy God am a jealous God...' All this is not in Madigan's text! Why is this so? The answer is because the Roman Catholic Church has deleted the above second commandment, (Ex.20:4,5; Dt.5:8,9), in their Catechisms and books, and split the tenth Commandment into two separate commandments, thus still maintaining ten commandments! Very few Catholics reading this column would be aware of this trickery. This is why Christian bookstores can sell plaques and gifts with ten commandments that can differ from each other. The Catholic plaques, while still having ten commandments simply have number two missing! When one considers the multi-million dollar Catholic industry created from the sale of images, it is not difficult to understand the reason for the deletion! More Messages from 'Mary'?

In the 'Ave Maria' No.24, supposed messages from Mary at Medjugorje were announced: (25/9/96)'...I am your mother and I wish to help you by seeking for you the grace from God...(25/10/96)'...I love you all and I call you to be closer to me and that your love towards my immaculate heart be more fervent. I wish to renew you and lead you with my heart to the heart of Jesus, which still today suffers for you and calls you to conversion and renewal. Through you I wish to renew the world'.

Can Mary really intercede or seek the grace of God for us? What does the Bible say?: 'For there is one God and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus', (1Tim.2:5, see also Heb.12:24). Can Mary really therefore 'lead us to the heart of Jesus'?

Likewise, who can 'renew' us but the Spirit of God Himself? Can Mary really 'renew the world', when the Bible says that after Jesus came and completed the finished work on Calvary, that the Holy Spirit alone was given for this express purpose.

In Times of Brokenness

Decade of Decline!

On the 7th. and 14th. of December 1986, Frank Houston, founder of (AOG) Christian Life Centre, Waterloo, Sydney, (and the driving force behind the planting of Christian life Centres throughout NSW), preached two sermons on the errors of the Roman Catholic Gospel. These were titled 'Who is the Holy Father?' and were meant to combat the many damning doctrines being espoused by the media as well as Protestant and Catholic leaders during the Pope's visit to Australia at that time.

He made clear, (sermon tapes on file at TA Ministries), his stance: 'I am talking tonight [7/12/86] about the system that I believe to be extremely wicked and anti-scriptural. I hope that people will get saved tonight as a result of this message'. He then plainly says that he in no way is vilifying Roman Catholics, but only the system they are involved with. The error of the continual sacrifice of the Mass, the Pauline curse against such a Gospel, and the absence of salvation in Roman Catholic sacraments, are thoroughly and Biblically set out. The next week, continuing, he says, 'I am having a go at a wicked. pernicious system known as Roman Catholicism which is condemned in the Bible and has its origin back in heathenism, in the days of Nimrod. Babylonianism is the very root of Roman Catholicism. It is a system that has brought a tremendous amount of suffering and hurt to countless millions down through the centuries. A system that is spoken about in the Word of God'. Space does not permit a full account of his exhaustive treatment of the Papacy. His hearers could have only come away with the informed opinion that the Vatican and all it stood for was Antichrist.

Just over a decade (of harvest?) later, the Assemblies of God in Australia have had a change of heart. Brian Houston, senior pastor of Hills Christian Life Centre, Sydney, (son of Frank, and now National Superintendent of the AOG in Australia), has endorsed the 'Share the Holy Spirit' conference to be held in Sydney, September 30th. - October 5th., 1997. His co-endorsees include: Pope John Paul 11, Nelson Mandela, Bishop Brian King (Anglican), Cardinal Edward Clancy (Catholic), Phil Pringle (Christian City Church), and Gordon Gibbs (Founder Pastor, Christian Life Centre, Penrith, NSW).

The speakers at this conference are listed, (eg. Dr. Tony Campolo, John and Paula Sandford, Guy Chevreau), and encompass Roman Catholicism, Eastern Orthodoxy, Lutheranism, and a field of selected sporting stars. Joseph Chircop (Roman Catholic) is the conference convenor and he says: 'The aim of these conferences is also to spiritually prepare ourselves for the 2000 Olympic Games, to make a local response to global evangelism as we approach the new millennium, as well as to break down barriers between peoples, (Gal.3:26). This year we have some famous sports people as well as having a more exciting youth programme. On behalf of my wife Julie, the leadership of the Servants of Jesus Community [ecumenical Roman Catholic], and the Catholic Charismatic renewal, I invite you to once again join us in our 1997 conference'.

Many Assemblies of God pastors of my acquaintance who have closed a blind eye to, gone along with, or been thoroughly deceived by the 'Toronto Blessing', Rodney Howard-Browne, Benny Hinn, and finally Pensacola, have nevertheless, a sound Biblical approach to the 'gospel' of Rome. Although warned by many of their brethren of the ecumenical spirit behind these people and their movements, they have to date chosen not to take heed.

Now finally, many of them will be challenged face to face by the glaring fact that their leadership are fully prepared to identify their denomination with Roman Catholicism and join with this false religious system in world evangelism.

It is simply staggering that Brian Houston could align the Assemblies of God in Australia, and Hills Christian Life Centre, with an organisation that pronounces *anathema* on Christian beliefs such as Faith, Scripture, and Christ alone; and is responsible for the martyrdom of millions of fellow saints; and a system that argues for purgatory, Mary as co-redemptrix, conferred sainthood, and a salvation found only within her precincts! It can only be a profound ignorance of history and scripture that would allow this.

Long and truthfully has it been said that the bridge between Rome and true Christianity would be finally built using the shared and spurious Charismatic and Pentecostal experience. After all, if Roman Catholics speak in tongues, prophesy, and fall about laughing, God must approve of their doctrines too...right?

The glaring need for a recovery of the Biblical mindset has never been clearer or more urgent. Leadership is now being weighed, and is found wanting. Disaster looms just ahead. An enormous shift has taken place within the church and only repentance and a return to Biblical discernment will produce a church that God will use for revival and genuine conversions.

God's great and terrible judgement is upon all those that would lead His dear sheep toward Rome, and it is our fervent prayer that those in positions of authority within the individual assemblies demand an explanation and repudiation immediately.

Ecumenism

(The following extracts were taken from an article in the 'Australian Beacon', 5/97)

'Adelaide churches are preparing for what could be the biggest Christian event since the Billy Graham rallies of the 1950's. Franklin Graham, the son of the famous evangelist, is to hold rallies...next year...which is expected to involve thousands of volunteers...[and] would demonstrate the unity of the church to the wider public. 'We want to rally people around the fact that we love the same God'...Training courses for volunteers will be held...Churches involved...include the Anglican, Catholic, Assemblies of God, Baptist, Lutheran and the Uniting churches.'

Our nation is already in the grip of apostasy and unbelief, which has been promoted not only by the ranks of liberalism, but also by the mass of evangelicals who appear to have lost their moorings. Evangelicals have capitulated on the question of whether or not Roman Catholics are Christians. This is highlighted by such 'evangelists' as Bill Newman and Billy Graham.

On April 5th this year a question was put to Bill Newman Crusades, 'Does Mr. Newman believe that the Roman Catholic church is Christian or pagan?' The answer from Gordon Lawson on behalf of the Bill Newman crusades (on April 11th) was 'Whilst you have requested answers to...you will appreciate our reluctance to do so'....Sadly we will find that Franklin Graham adopts the same attitude towards Rome...Included in the churches supporting the 1998 Franklin Graham meetings are Roman Catholic, Anglican, Uniting, Baptist, Assemblies of God and Lutheran!...Woe to anyone who dares to speak against it. The men and women who gave their lives in the history of the Christian church that we might have a Bible and clear Biblical teaching, such would be horrified at such trends today...all in the cause of 'love'. But the Bible reminds us that true love always tells the truth...'What fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness, and what communion hath light with darkness?...(2Cor.6:14-16). The call is for separation.' (Australian Beacon, 5/97)
