Qs.3 Was the gifts of healing or the gift of tongues for everyone? 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Qs.1 (c). There are at least 19 gifts (5 gifts in Romans 12; 5 gifts in Ephesians 4; and 9 'sign gifts' in 1Corinthians 12).

Qs.2 (c). The Bible lists 'tongues' in a descending order as the least of the gifts (1Cor.12:28-30)

Qs.3 (d). 1Cor.12:30

Qs.4 (e) Both c and d. (Lk.7:18-22; Jn.20:30,31; Acts 2:22; 2Cor.12:12; Heb.2:3,4)

Qs.5. True. Is.35:4-6; 61:1,2

Qs.6 False. The context in 1Peter 2:24,25 is healing for 'sins' for those sheep who were 'going astray'. The healing is for their 'souls' (vs.25). 1Pet.2:24,25 is also a quote from Isaiah 53: 4-6 which again states the healing is 'for our transgressions...for our iniquities...the Lord has laid on him the iniquity of us all'. Qs.7 **False**. Jesus died for our sin - has been the teaching of the church for 1,900 years until the turn of the 20th Century when 'healing ministries' were spawned within the new Pentecostal movement.

Qs.8 False. 2Cor.12:7-9; Phil.2:25; 2Tim.4:20; 1Tim.5:23

Qs.9 **True**. Jesus and his disciples healed 'all' & 'every' (Matt.4:23,24; 8:16; 9:35; 10:1; 12:15...*Instantly* (Matt.8:3; 20:34); completely (Matt.12:13,15; 14:36; 15:28... and at will (Matt.8:3).

Qs.10 False. Many diseases have *never* been healed by *any* faith healers (Down's Syndrome, Aids, etc). Jesus and his disciples healed '*all manner of diseases*' (Matt.4:23; 10:1) such as the *lame, blind, dumb, maimed* (Matt.15:30,31).

Qs.11 **False**. The opposite is stated - there will be 'lying' and false signs and wonders (Matt.24:24; 2Thess.2:9-11).

Qs.12 **True**. This is unanimously attested to by the early church fathers and by church leaders and commentators down the centuries.
